**Marriage:** Couples contemplating marriage should meet with the priest at least eight months prior to the date of the celebration. No date can be reserved until the pre-nuptial investigation has been completed.

**Reconciliation:** Sunday and Wednesday 10 minutes before mass, or by appointment.

**Anointing of the Sick:** Anointing of the Sick is for the comfort and strength of the ill, especially the aged. It is not just for those in the immediate danger of death. The sacraments are celebrated for the living. When someone you love is homebound or hospitalized, please let us know so arrangements can be made to minister to them.

**Funerals:** In the event of a death in your immediate family, please call the priest at St. Madeleine's Church (386)454-2358.

**Membership Information:** If you wish to become a member of the church, or to sign up for a church ministry, please pick up a registration form found at the back of the church, or call the church office. We can also email or fax forms.

**Intentions for Loved Ones:** If you would like to have a mass said for your loved one, sponsor the tabernacle light, or sponsor the mass hosts in memory of a loved one, please call or email the church office. **If your intention is for a specific date,** please call the office well in advance, as dates fill up quickly.

## Baptism of the Lord



### First Week of Ordinary Time

Sunday is the **Baptism of the Lord**. We hear the Lord say in the first reading from **Isaiah**, "Here is my servant whom I uphold, my chosen one with whom I am pleased, upon whom I have put my spirit." That is echoed in **Luke's Gospel**, after Jesus' baptism: "And a voice came from heaven, "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased."

This feast marks the end of the **Christmas season** and on Monday we begin **Ordinary Time** on the Church calendar. The term Ordinary doesn't mean that the life of the Church is ordinary but that it is *ordinal* or "counted." We mark our liturgical year by counting 34 weeks of Ordinary Time, interrupted only by the Lent/Easter seasons. When the liturgical year ends in November with the 34th Week in Ordinary Time, it is followed by the First Week in Advent.

During this first week in Ordinary Time, we begin a four week cycle of weekday readings from the **Letter to the Hebrews**. This is the longest letter to any community in the New Testament.

For the next eight weeks, until the beginning of Lent, the weekday gospels are from **Mark's Gospel**. Mark offers us a look this week at the beginning of Jesus public ministry. He drives out evil spirits, heals the sick and forgives sins to the skepticism of the scribes. Jesus extends an invitation to the despised tax collector, Levi/Matthew "Follow me."

The **Second Sunday of Ordinary Time** offers us beautiful readings. From the **Prophet Isaiah**: "I will make you a light to the nations..." In **John's Gospel** John the Baptist and his followers see Jesus as he walks toward them. John says, "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world. He is the one of whom I said, 'A man is coming after me who ranks ahead of me because he existed before me.'"

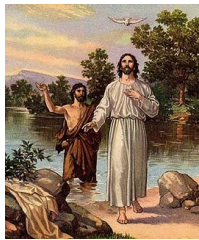
