### Sacraments

**Marriage:** Couples contemplating marriage should meet with the priest at least eight months prior to the date of the celebration. No date can be reserved until the pre-nuptial investigation has been completed.

**Reconciliation:** Sunday and Wednesday 10 minutes before mass, or by appointment.

**Anointing of the Sick:** Anointing of the Sick is for the comfort and strength of the ill, especially the aged. It is not just for those in the immediate danger of death. The sacraments are celebrated for the living. When someone you love is homebound or hospitalized, please let us know so arrangements can be made to minister to them.

**Funerals:** In the event of a death in your immediate family, please call the priest at St. Madeleine's Church (386)454-2358.

**Membership Information:** If you wish to become a member of the church, or to sign up for a church ministry, please pick up a registration form found at the back of the church, or call the church office. We can also email or fax forms.

**Intentions for Loved Ones:** If you would like to have a mass said for your loved one, sponsor the tabernacle light, or sponsor the mass hosts in memory of a loved one, please call or email the church office. **If your intention is for a specific date,** please call the office well in advance, as dates fill up quickly.

## Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

### The Thirteenth Week of Ordinary Time

Sunday is the **Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ**. This week is a great preparation for our journey with Jesus more deeply into the mystery of self-giving love. "I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world."

This is a week filled with special days. Tuesday is the **Memorial of Saint Irenaeus, bishop and martyr**. Wednesday is the **Solemnity of Saint Peter and Saint Paul, Apostles** with its own special readings. Friday is the **Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus** with its own readings. Saturday is the **Memorial of the Immaculate Heart of The Blessed Virgin Mary**.

During this week the gospels are interrupted several times with special days, but the ordinary narrative from **Genesis** offers stories of Abraham's relationship with the Lord, from the destruction of Sodom and Gomorrah to his willingness to sacrifice his own son. His wife, Sarah becomes jealous of the son Abraham had by Hagar, the slave, and forces Abraham to drive Hagar and her son, Ishmael, out into the desert, where they are saved by God. Sarah dies, and Abraham prepares for the end of his own life by searching for a wife for his son, Isaac. The Genesis readings close the week with the story of Isaac's wife, Rebekah, deceiving her now-elderly and blind husband into giving his blessing and birthright to her favored son, Jacob.

The **Psalms** this week offers praise to God for his mercy and faithfulness to us.

**Matthew's Gospel** follows Jesus on his journeys, constantly teaching his disciples about faithfulness. He heals the sick, calms a violent storm at sea and forgives sins. At the end of the week, he does something extraordinary - he invites the reviled tax collector, Matthew, to be one of his followers. Then he indicates that the old ways of relating to God are gone - that he is the new way, the new wineskin.

**The Fourteenth Week in Ordinary Time** begins with a Sunday that offers pastoral comfort to us all. In the **Zechariah** reading, the Lord promises Israel, and us, a savior who "shall proclaim peace to the nations." **Matthew's gospel** points to Jesus as the source of that peace, as he affirms his identity as the Son of God. Jesus offers himself as a relief from the burdens of our days, promising "you will find rest for yourselves. For my yoke is easy, and my burden light."

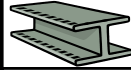
