**How to Use the Books in the Pews**

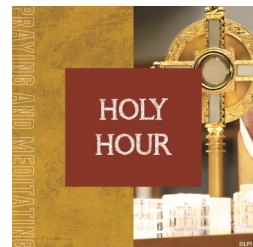

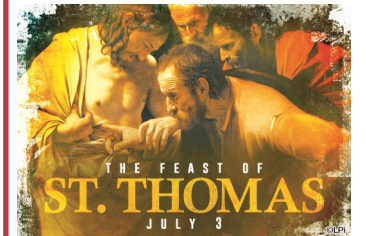

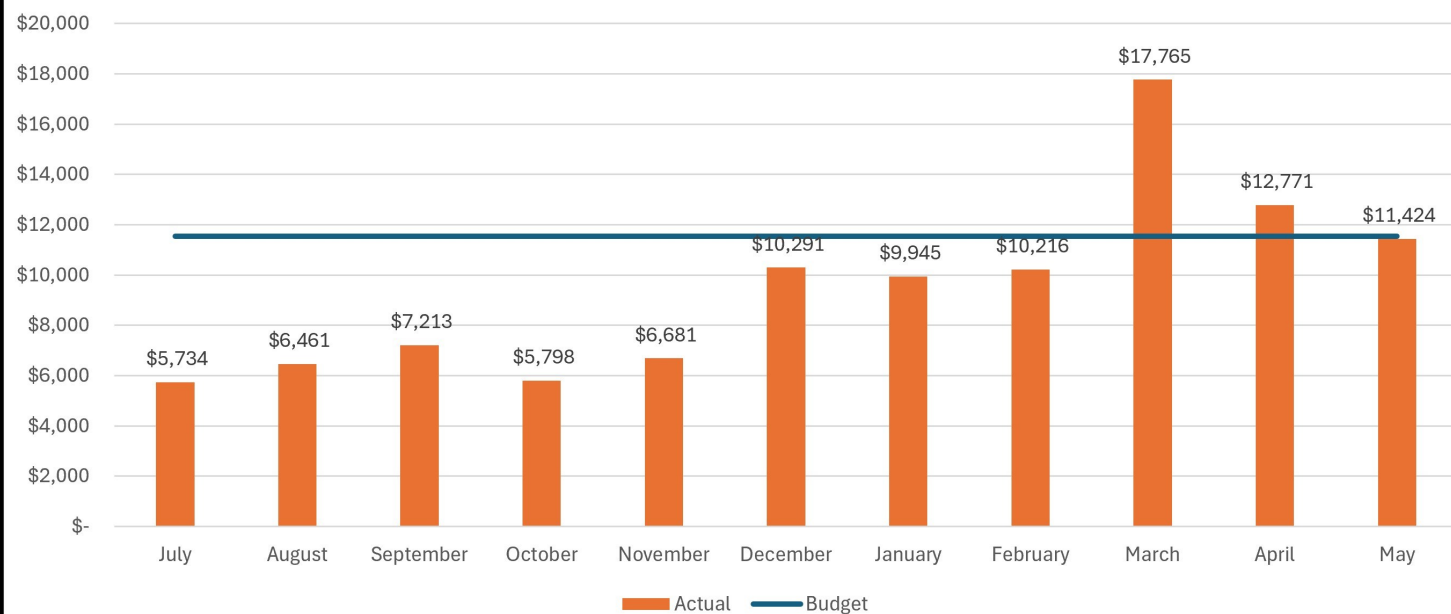
